### **STÄDTISCHES LAPIDARIUM – SCULPTURES AND STONES OF STUTT GART’S PAST**

A Lapidarium is a place where stone monuments and fragments of archaeological interest are exhibited. Located in an idyllic Italian Renaissance Garden, the Lapidarium in Stuttgart has over 200 such monuments ranging from sculptures, to tiles, to remnants of buildings destroyed in the bombings of WW II as well as from the urban renewal in Stuttgart back in 1900. Though many are damaged, they are reminders of the cultural and archaeological history of Stuttgart from centuries past. After a 1.5 hour guided tour (in German), we will go to the nearby Karlshöhe Biergarten.

The tour is in German and costs 3 Euros for non-members. Members do not pay for the guided tour. This is a joint program with the Metropolitan Club Stuttgart.
